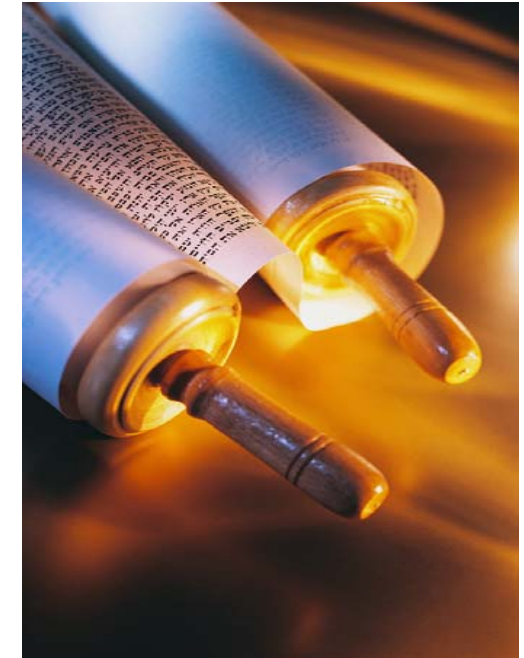

The Alien Sinner Must:
